Can Almsgiving Atone for Sin? This Bible study will focus on the biblical teaching about the merit God associates with almsgiving, from the OT to the NT. We will


also touch on how Luther's Reformation changed the Christian tradition and how that relates to Scripture.

Fr. Kevin's Cluttered Desk

I would like to begin by thanking all of those who helped in celebrating my 25th anniversary. Over the last few weeks many people have told me that anniversaries are important, and I suppose they are but for me, if 25 or 40 years from now people still remember me and say I was wonderful, my question would be "do you still go to church and receive the Eucharist?" If I haven't pointed you to Jesus, if I haven't caused you to reflect and depend on your relationship with God, if I haven't brought you to the Eucharist, if I haven't shared with you the healing power of the Eucharist, then I have failed you as a priest. It must be remembered that a priest is a sign-post, maybe a fancy one or a plain one, but always a sign-post pointing to Jesus. The spiritual fatherhood of a priest finds its home in God the Father, for all are welcome and all are family and often a broken family. And so, the priest points to Jesus the healer; the healer of our body, the healer of our soul, and the healer of our mind. Jesus worked through Peter to perform great miracles but Peter was not the healer, Jesus was. Jesus works through all of us if we let Him, and this is why the priest must be a sign-post, for even though we were created for incorruption and are images of God, we are also sinners in need of God's endless mercy and love. And so the priest points to the one who is perfect and is perfect love, the one who died for us, the one who brought us to salvation. Within each of us is that perfect one and in the Eucharist we unite ourselves to the one, the one who is all in all. In the Mass the priest in "Persona Christi Capita" calls down the Spirit upon the gifts of bread and wine that they might be changed into the body and blood of Jesus but even here the priest is a signpost pointing the way to eternal life. Yes, anniversaries are important, but feeding the flock with Jesus so they might follow the signs to eternal life and live with Him forever, that's the great celebration.
