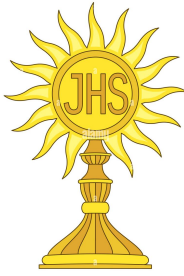

Stewardship Reflection

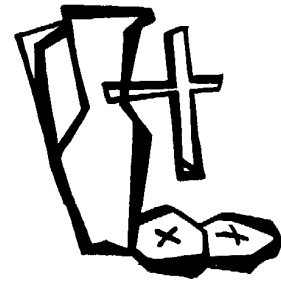
Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother. (Mark 3.35)

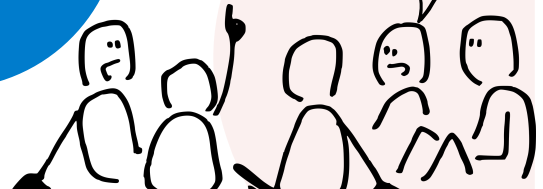

Fr. Kevin's Cluttered Desk

I would like to begin with a big thank you to all those who helped in any way to make our Corpus Christi Procession such a huge success. I must share one little story though. It seems a gentleman in a truck was a bit upset with us and said some harsh words and wanted to know what we were protesting. Upon being informed we were asking people to pray for peace, he calmed right down and said no more. Now this is the short form of what transpired but for me it was a moment of, our world today really does protest a lot, maybe we should pray more and protest less. But then we have become a secular world and prayer is no longer a concept for many. In our secular world everyone is a victim or at least it would appear so, and we have lost our sense of oneness, one people one country. In the gospel Jesus reminds us that a house or kingdom divided against itself cannot stand and it will fall, and it will be plundered. One might want to look at our own country and how our government is constantly throwing money at groups of people almost to the point that some people are more special than other people. The Corpus Christi procession reminds us that we are united in Jesus Christ and Jesus is our Saviour and we pray for His peace in the world and our country. In a few weeks we will celebrate Canada Day, a moment to remind ourselves that we who hold a Canadian passport are Canadian; one people, one country made up of many parts, many nations and much diversity, but always one country with St. Joseph and Mary watching over us, and we pray. Sometimes the most important part of life is looking for what we share in common, not what divides, seeking peaceful solutions and not turning to acts of violence and destruction. A house divided will never stand.
