

Blessings of Cinco de Mayo, or the fifth of May be with all of you. Cinco de Mayo is a holiday that celebrates the date of the Mexican army's May 5 1862 victory over France at the Battle of Puebla during the Franco-Mexican War. The day, which falls on Sunday this year, is also known as Battle of Puebla Day. While it is a relatively minor holiday in Mexico, in the United States and other parts of the world, Cinco de Mayo has evolved into a commemoration of Mexican culture and heritage, particularly in areas with large Mexican American populations. So get out your cookbook and try something of the Mexican variety. What has this got to do with the 6th Sunday of Easter? In our readings today we are reminded that God shows no partiality, we are all God's children and God loves every one of us unconditionally and expects us to do the same. Equality in the eyes of God has nothing to do with sameness, but everything to do with respect and honor for difference. God created all of us and God does not create junk. When God created us God created us in "His likeness and image", which makes everyone of us beautiful and wondrous in His eyes. Having said that God did not create us "the same" for we are not all the same, but we were all created with gifts and talents to be used to build up God's kingdom here on earth. What does this require from each of us? It requires us to lift each other up, support each other, and encourage each other to discover and use the gifts God has given us. We need to rejoice that we are not the same and at the same time rejoice and celebrate our differences and the many gifts God has given us. So eat a little Mexican food, or maybe some Spanish food, or listen to some Mexican music, but always rejoice in and with all of God's children.
